Location

Endeavour College of Natural Health's Gold Coast campus is located on levels 1 & 2 at 121 Scarborough Street in Southport, close to public transport, several shopping and restaurant districts as well as popular parklands and beaches. The entrance to the college is on Welch Street.

Campus facilities include an extensive library of physical collections and online resources, student common areas and kitchen facilities, fit for purpose classroom and laboratory settings, onsite teaching clinics, and access to local Student Advisers during College operating hours.



How to get to Gold Coast campus

Train, Bus and Tram

The Scarborough Street, Southport Transit Centre is located 200m down the road from the campus, an approximate 5 minute walk away. This is the main hub for all bus and train connections on the Gold Coast. Based on your location this would be an ideal point to connect to your bus or train route in the area.

The G: link is the Gold Coast city tram network, and the nearest station is located a short 8 minute walk from the College. The G: Link runs from the Gold Coast University Hospital to Broadbeach South and makes any connection between these areas fast and convenient.

Cycling

If you wish to ride your bike to Campus, there are a range of bike racks near the College. The closest is on Scarborough Street outside the front of the Nexus Towers complex grassed area and the Southport transit centre.

Parking

There are a number of car parks within 3-10 minutes walk of the campus. The closest is located off Marshall Lane, directly behind the college. The Mal Burke Carpark is located off Scarborough Street on Hicks Street. These car parks are managed by the Gold Coast City Council and offer a discounted daily rate. There are also numerous metered car parks on Scarborough and Welch Street in easy walking distance to the college.

Nearby Cafes and Shopping

The Bank Café

Located behind the Bank of Queensland in the Nexus Towers complex, a short 3 minute walk towards the centre of Southport. They enjoy catering to Endeavour students and have added turmeric lattes, gluten free and raw treats to their menu. They are also supportive of requests to provide healthy alternative treats.

Giri Kana Café

Located just down the road on the corner of Marine Parade and Nind Street, this café specialises in an organic, vegetarian and vegan selections, an absolute favourite destination.

Teaching Facilities

The Gold Coast Campus is clean, bright and spacious. It offers our students various places to study and learn with the following facilities available:

Library

Located on level 2 of the campus, the library has a large collection of text books and references. There are 4 library computers available for students as well as photocopying services.

Student Break-out and Balcony

Located on Level 1, the Student Break-out and Balcony area provides a great space for students to congregate between classes. Students have access to kitchen facilities and tables to relax or catch up with friends.

Toilets

Male and female toilets are located in the foyer on levels 1 and 2. The level 1 facilities require a pin code which can be obtained from Student Services. There is also an accessible toilet with baby changing facilities on level 2 in the southern hallway.

Lecture Rooms

Our Lecture rooms are roomy and practical and offer students a comfortable place to learn. All classes are scheduled in the same room for every week of a semester so you can relax and enjoy the space.

WHS Responsibility

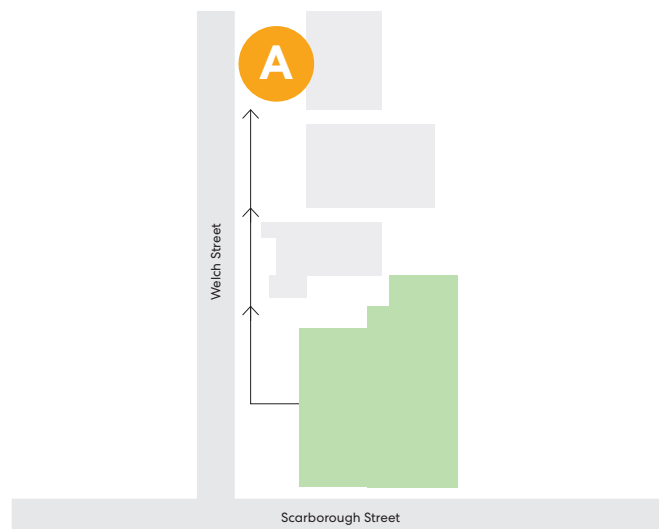

Emergency Response Team Contact Details

There are posters dotted all around the Campus and Clinic with useful and important emergency contact details and information including first aid officers on site, security, and the critical response team.

Fire or Emergency Evacuation Procedure

In the event of any emergency and a warden advises you to vacate the building please follow instructions and make your way to the designated Muster Point which is on the grassed area at the front of 16 Welch Street, Southport.



In the event of a fire please follow the below procedure:

1. When you hear the announcement to EVACUATE, please follow instructions and evacuate the building. Under the instruction of the Wardens, evacuate the building via the Emergency Exit. If no wardens are present, evacuate the building immediately via your nearest Exit.
DO NOT USE LIFT – ONLY FIRE STAIRS
2. Do not panic. Move to the assembly area (Grass area in front of 16 Welch Street, Southport)
3. Do not return to the building until given the "All Clear" by the Chief Warden or Emergency Services.

First Aid

Designated Workplace First Aid Officers (DWFAOs):

Details of the DWFAO's on Campus can be found on the Emergency Response Team Contact Details posters. ALL clinic supervisors are trained to perform first aid so at any time there should be at least one DWFAO on Campus.

There are First Aid Kits located in a few places on Campus:

- Library Reception
- Student Services
- Clinic Reception
- Room 1.05 (The Lab)

We also have 2 x Epi Pens on Campus they can be found, along with the Anaphylaxis procedure, in the Student Services and Clinic First Aid Kits.

Our Campus Defibrillator can be found next to the Clinic Reception.

After Hours Security

Our premises are monitored by Wilson Security, and we have CCTV in most areas of the campus. There is an after-hours number (1300 945766, Prompt 1) that students can call should they lock themselves out of the building. This is so that other members of staff aren't called out late at night or on weekends. Individuals will need to provide their Endeavour ID Card or provide their Student ID Number when requesting. There may be a small charge to access this service.

Student ID Cards

Once your enrolment has been confirmed at Endeavour College of Natural Health, you should obtain a student ID Card. While student cards are not mandatory, Endeavour College of Natural Health does encourage students to obtain their student ID. Your ID can be used to borrow books from the library and identify yourself for exams and for safety purposes when on campus. If you do not wish to request a student ID, you are still able to use any form of recognised ID in your online exams such as your driver's license, passport, or 18+ card.

To arrange your Endeavour student card please email library.online@endeavour.edu.au with the following information and items:

- A copy of photo ID (passport, licence etc.)
- A photo of you against a white background
- Your home campus
- Your student ID number

Please allow one week of processing time before contacting the library for an update.

Student Campus Access Card

Current students must apply for a student campus access card if they are requiring access to the Gold Coast Campus's clinic/class. Access through the ground floor doors and lift to levels 1 & 2 is available between 7.30am and 6.00pm. Internal access to the campus space is available between 8.00am and 4.00pm (core operational hours) – outside these hours an access card will be required to gain entry into the campus space. Student campus access cards are requested as follows:

1. IN PERSON – Visit Student Services reception, fill out an application form, and receive a card quickly
2. DIGITALLY – Visit our website and go to the college forms section and search for access card.

Download and complete the form and submit using a facilities ticket via the student help desk.

You will receive an email when your card is ready to collect from Student Services. Your card will allow you to access to the campus via the front door by swiping your card on the reader. This card is required to gain entry to the campus prior to 8.00am and after 4.00pm.

Please note, if you lose your card, you must notify Student Services immediately for security purposes. A replacement card costs \$25.00 which you can pay by Eftpos at the Student Services desk.
